Last night, Heidi informed the Board of Trustees that this will be her final school year as Waverly's Head of School.

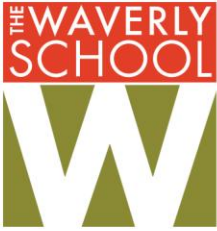
