Faculty, administration, and staff spent today working to establish a remote learning program for all students. We are still in the process of finalizing specific details. On Monday, we will continue to meet and collaborate, and by the end of the workday, send grade/class specific instructions for your child(ren) to begin the remote learning program starting Tuesday morning.

*Elementary School*

Elementary parents should plan to check their child(ren)'s PSL page by 8:30 each morning. Students in grades 1-6 will be assigned a minimum of 3.5 hours of learning activities each day. We will also be posting suggested activities for our preschool and kindergarten students.

*Middle and High School*

Middle and high school students and families will receive a daily email with specific instructions for the day. Students in the middle and high schools will be assigned 3.5 to 5 hours of work daily.

This weekend, please ensure that you have a computer with reliable access to the internet. If this is not available to your student, please contact [Jason](#) or [Joel](#). Furthermore, students should be carving out time and space to complete their daily assignments.
